

## To vow to other than Allah is an act of Shirk

Quranic Ayah 1

Insan: 7

وَقَوْلُ اَللَّهِ تَعَالَى ﴿يُوفُونَ بِالنَّذْرِ ﴾.

They (are those who) fulfill (their) vows...

Quranic Ayah 2

Al-Baqara - 270

وَقَوْلُهُ ﴿وَمَا أَنْفَقْتُمْ مِنْ نَفَقَةٍ أَوْ نَذَرْتُمْ مِنْ نَذْرٍ فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ يَعْلَمُهُ ﴾.

And whatever you spend for spendings (e.g., in Sadaqah - charity, etc. for Allah's Cause) or whatever vow you make, be sure Allah knows it all

وَفِي اَلصَّحِيحِ عَنْ عَائِشَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهَا أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ « مَنْ نَذَرَ أَنْ يُطِيعَ اللَّهَ فَلْيُطِعْهُ, وَمَنْ نَذَرَ أَنْ يُطِيعَ اللَّهَ فَلْيُطِعْهُ, وَمَنْ نَذَرَ أَنْ يُطِيعَ اللَّهَ فَلْيُطِعْهُ, وَمَنْ نَذَرَ أَنْ يَعْصِيَى اللَّهَ فَلَا يَعْصِهِ »(1) .

Narrated 'Aishah (May Allah be pleased with him) that Allah's Messenger (May the peace and blessing of Allah be upon him) said:

"Whoever vows that he will be obedient to Allah, he should be obedient to Him; and whoever made a vow that he will disobey Allah, he should not disobey Him".

Important issues of the Chapter:	فِيهِ مَسَائِلُ:
وُجُوبُ الْوَفَاءِ بِالنَّذْرِ.	الْأُولَى:
Fulfillment of the vow is obligatory.	
إِذَا ثَبَتَ كَوْنُهُ عِبَادَةَ اللَّهِ, فَصَرْفُهُ إِلَى غَيْرِهِ شِرْكٌ.	الثَّانِيَةُ:
Since it is approved that making a	
vow is an act of worship to Allah,	
then directing a vow to other than	
Allah is committing Shirk.

Any vow based on disobedience (to	
Allah the Almighty) is impermissible	
to be carried out
